You hear the powerful improvised authentic ensemble sounds of the Kid Thomas, George Lewis, Punch Miller, and Kid Howard bands, the small jazz ensemble of John Handy, the raunchy, gutsy singing of Pamela Polland and the delightful swing of the Golden Age Jazz Band who carry on the New Orleans jazz tradition on the West Coast.

Recorded in New Orleans at Cosimo's studio on May 17 and 19, 1971. Produced by Chris Strachwitz & Lars Edegran. Previously issued on ARH 1058 which is still available as LP or Cassette.

Punch Miller's New Orleans Band: Punch Miller – trumpet, Israel Gorman – clarinet, Albert Warner – trombone, George Guesnon – banjo, Wilbert Tillman – tuba, Alex Bigard – drums. Recorded by Ken Mills in New Orleans on August 31, 1962. Previously issued on ARH 1013.

George Lewis with George Guesnon's New Orleans Stompers: George Lewis – clarinet, Kid Thomas – trumpet, Jim Robinson – trombone, George Guesnon – banjo, John Joseph – bass, Josiah "CiE" Frazier – drums. Recorded by Ken Mills on August 28, 1962. Previously issued on ARH 1013.
