HOWEVER, AFTER THESE MANY YEARS (6), ON RE-HEARING, THE "SPIRIT" OF THE PERFORMANCES WAS SO GOOD THAT FOLKWAYS FELT THAT IT WOULD BE A SHAME NOT TO HAVE ITS MANY FRIENDS HEAR THEM.
