



Biography: Max Ferguson (Rawhide)

Announcer-comedian Max Ferguson is a native of Durham, England, the son of Irish parents. But he has lived most of his life in London, Ontario, where he graduated from the University of Western Ontario in 1946. In the summer holidays he had played with a radio stock company in London and neighbouring districts. Practically from infancy he had wanted to be a teacher, but his family and teachers discouraged him from this idea.

After graduation he went to station CFPL, London, as an announcer. A few months later he joined the CBC and went to Halifax, where he found himself the sole heir to a hill-billy show.

After the first show -- After Breakfast Breakdown -- an old character called Rawhide drew the unprecedented number of 3,000 fan letters, and they kept coming in at that rate day after day. Rawhide, who turned out to be Max, was bewildered, but happy. And his show has been a howling success ever since.

He describes Rawhide as a westerner with a shady background, age unknown. Max is a man of many voices, an art he has been practising since he used to mimic his teachers in school. During the show as many as fourteen different characters, all interpreted by him, turn up at once on Rawhide's show, between recordings of hill-billy, cowboy and semi-classical tunes. His repertoire includes about two dozen voices.

Max was transferred to the CBC's Toronto studios in 1949, but his love of the Maritimes was very strong. He spent most of his summer holidays on Canada's east coast, and finally moved back to Halifax in August 1954.

A highlight of his program is his take-off on different CBC shows, in which he acts all the parts himself, in voices ranging from soprano to bass, and with tongue-in-cheek abandon.

Max is married to a cute little red-head - the former Norma Fraser of Wolfville - whom he met in Halifax. They have three children.

TAPE TWO, A:
Sherlock Holmes "The Case of the Speckled Band".

The only explanation to be offered for the shocking way in which poor Sherlock comes off at the hands of the Rawhide boys is that, all through his brilliant career, Holmes was always right. This places him in the same category as Ma Perkins -- the true kiss of death as far as Rawhide's boys are concerned. Holmes' shattered prestige throughout the drama is finally salvaged in the rather poignant epilogue spoken by the most notorious adversary ever encountered by Holmes -- the Irish footpad, Moriarity. In the rich, soft brogue of his native Ireland, this notorious renegade offers this tribute to Holmes..... "Oive been chased by de pullace of every country in the world, but oi've got to admit ... be he ever so humble, sure dere's no pullace like Holmes."

# TAPE TWO, B:

Canadian Scene "Operation Kate". In the finest tradition of CBC Outside Broadcasts, Marvin Mellobell brings us a word picture of one of the Canadian army's largest training schemes in the far north. The purpose of the scheme, involving 15,000 men, is to test the worth of Kate Aitken's latest cookbook which she is hoping to sell to the Canadian government entitled.... "25 Wonderful Things You Can Do With Snow." The actual voices of paratroopers in the field are heard not to mention a dear old soul of 90 who drifts down onto the Arctic waste hurling imprecations at TCA's service and the rude stewardess with the handle-bar moustache who pushed her out when all she wanted to do was visit her sister in Winnipeg.

TAPE ONE, A:

"Le College Des Hommes De Garbage". In this on the spot interview Roving Reporter, Marvin Mellobell, offers a report on this exciting new institution dedicated to raising the standards of garbage collecting. The only school of its kind in the world, this non-denominational institution offers to the fledgling garbage student a two year course leading to his BGC -- Bachelor of Garbage Collecting. Courses in the history of garbage collecting from pre-Renaissance days, self-defence against children and dogs, correct dress and general deportment are offered to the undergraduate. By applying the rudiments of ballet to the art of garbage collecting, the school is able to bring out in its students an awareness of the inherent grace and beauty to be found in this much under-estimated vocation.

# TAPE ONE, B:

"Visit to Santa's Workshop".

In one of the most unusual radio broadcasts ever attempted, Roving Reporter, Marvin Mellobell, takes us behind the scenes at Santa's workshop -- heretofore unseen by the eyes of man or Kate Aitken. We meet the adorable little elves and learn of their problems, we learn the secret of Santa's perpetual joviality. The only disconcerting aspect of the entire interview is Santa's annoying habit of bursting into his merry "oh-ho-ho's" each time the intrepid Mellobell attempts to sneak in a eulogy of the CBC. On such occasions, the listener can almost detect a snide quality to the old fellow's usually merry laughter.
