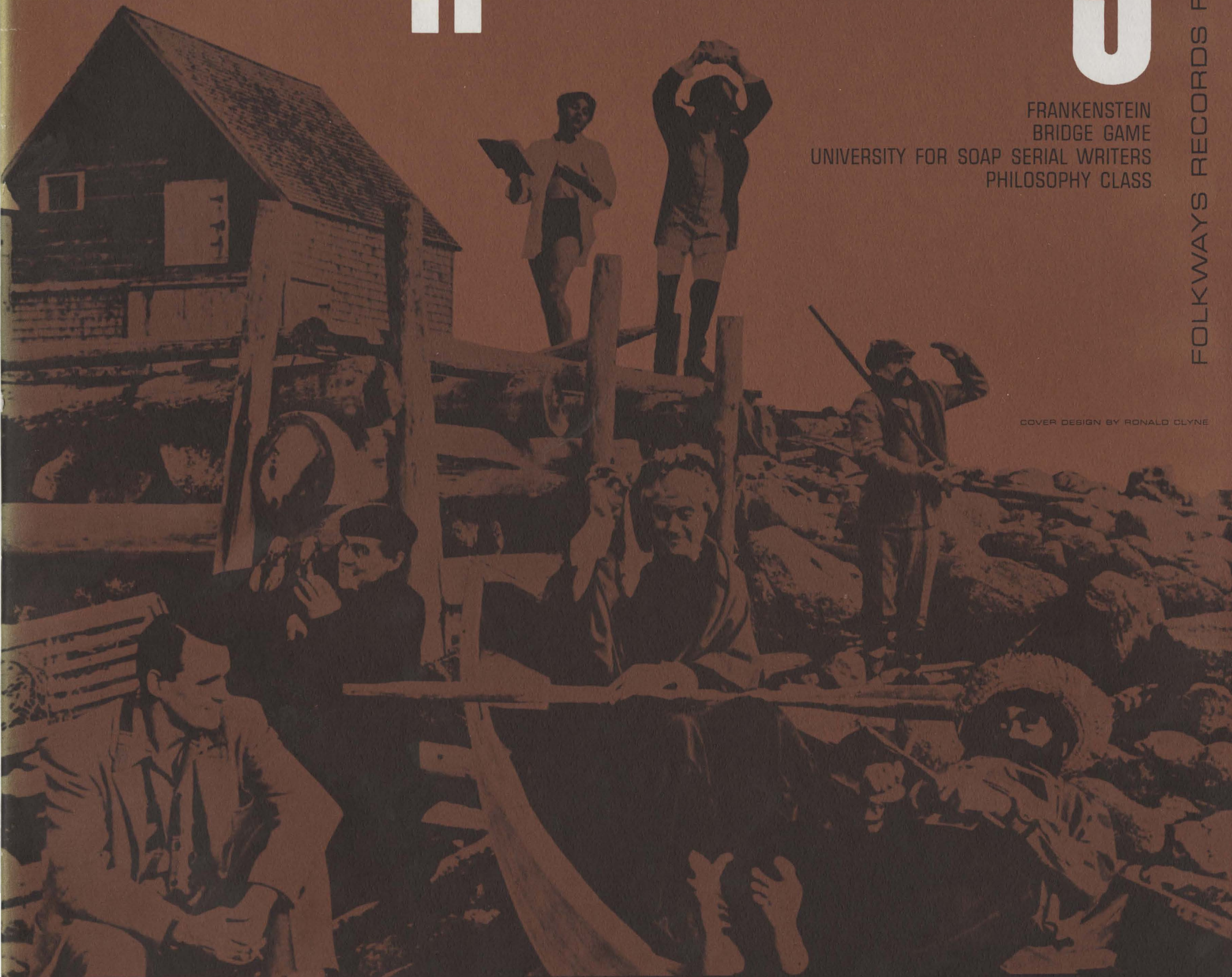

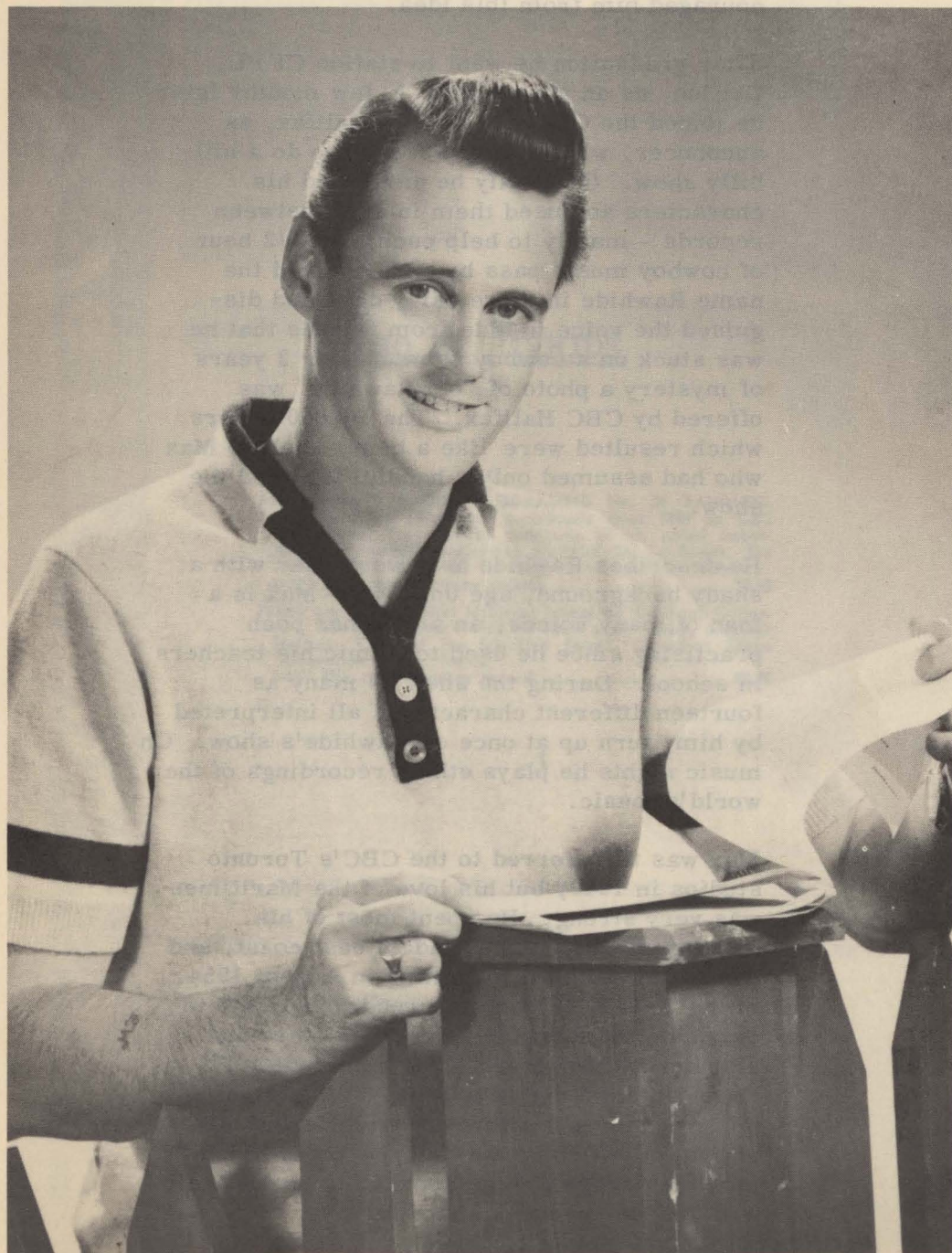

Biography: Max Ferguson (Rawhide)

Max Ferguson is a native of Durham, England, the son of Irish parents. He grew up in London, Ontario, where he graduated from the University of Western Ontario in 1946. Practically from infancy he had wanted to be a teacher, but his family and teachers discouraged him from this idea.

After graduation he went to station CFPL, London, as an announcer. A few months later he joined the CBC and went to Halifax, as announcer, where he was forced to do a hill-billy show. Gradually he developed his characters and used them in skits between records - mainly to help each long 1/2 hour of cowboy music pass by. He adopted the name Rawhide in those early days and disguised the voice to hide from friends that he was stuck on a cowboy show. After 2 years of mystery a photo of "old Rawhide" was offered by CBC Halifax. The 10,000 letters which resulted were like a bomb-shell to Max who had assumed only a handful followed the show.

He describes Rawhide as a westerner with a shady background, age unknown. Max is a man of many voices, an art he has been practising since he used to mimic his teachers in school. During the show as many as fourteen different characters, all interpreted by him, turn up at once on Rawhide's show. On music nights he plays ethnic recordings of the world's music.

Max was transferred to the CBC's Toronto studios in 1949, but his love of the Maritimes was very strong. He spent most of his summer holidays on Canada's east coast, and finally moved back to Halifax in August 1954. In the Fall of 1958 he returned to Toronto to originate the Rawhide show from there and also act as host on the CBC's interview TV show tabloid 5 nights a week. A highlight of his program is his take-off on different CBC shows, in which he acts all the parts himself, in voices ranging from soprano to bass, and with tongue-in-cheek abandon.

Max is married to the former Norma Fraser of Wolfville, N.S. whom he met in Halifax. They have 5 children and a Newfoundland dog.
