Recorded probably in the region of Ewendo, prior to 1959. The language is similar to that of the Fang inhabiting much of the Gabon, and therefore it is presumed that the tribal group belongs to the Bulu, Yaunde, or related ethnic groups. Little else is known about this recording, except that it was made in a large dwelling, probably a mission church.

The words given in the psalms are phonetic approximations of the lines sung by the chorus. The translation that follows is equally approximate and it may even be faneiful.
