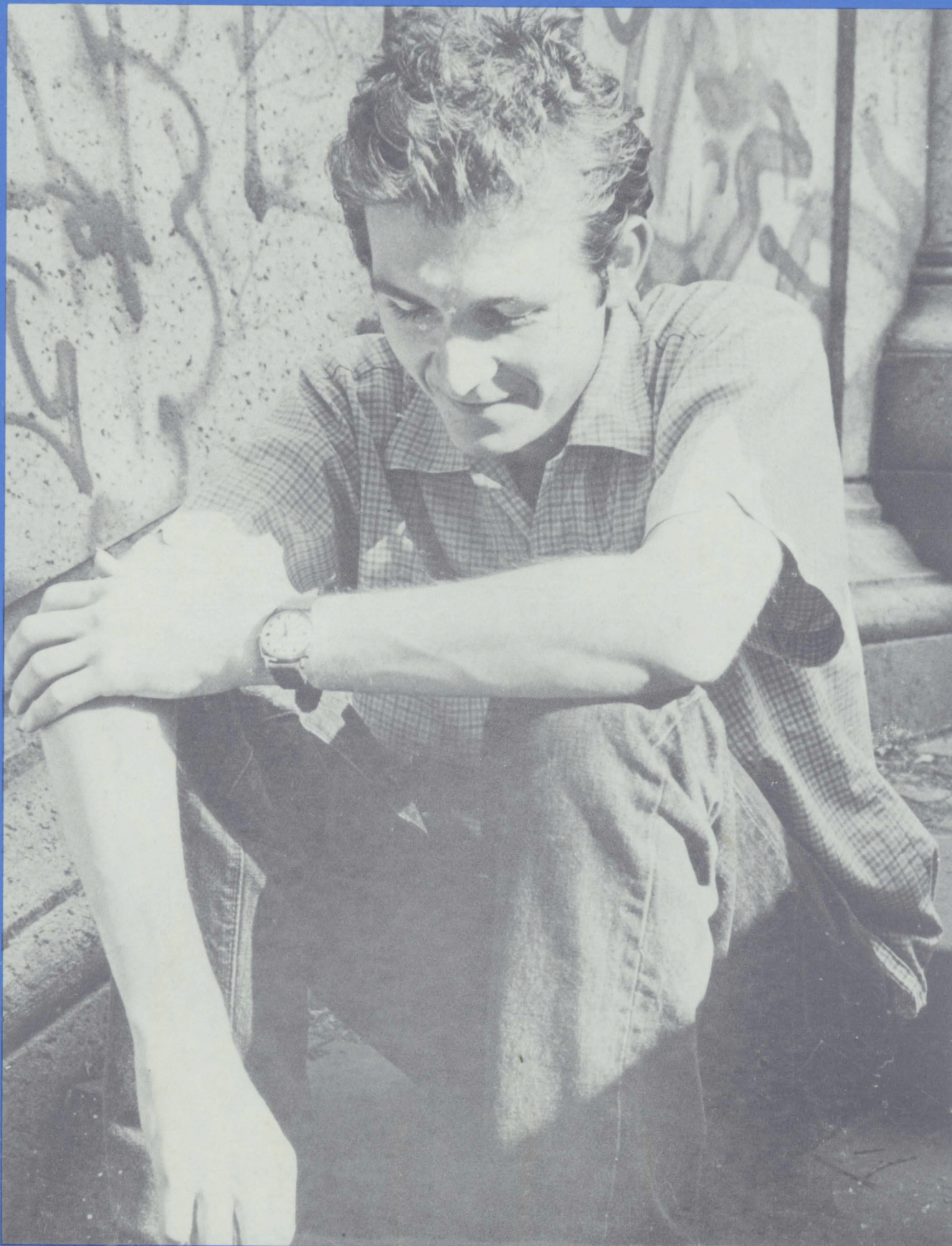

The first time I heard Woody Guthrie sing was when I was about fifteen years old. I came across his record album, "Dust Bowl Ballads" in the Atlanta public library. Up to that time, the only thing that I knew about him was that he was the guy who had written "This Land Is Your Land." I was taken with Woody from that initial spin of the disc, I guess partly because he sang in the traditional Southern style; simple country phrasing and words about the people and events around him. Since I had been brought up on the records of the Carter Family and Hank Williams, Woody's style immediately appealed to me. His voice and guitar pickin' weren't the best I had ever heard, but there was something special in the words he was singing and something unique to me in what he was singing about.

I had been playing the guitar a couple of years or so when I heard that first Woody Guthrie record, and from that point on, I can't think of hardly anyone who has had as much influence on my own singing and song writing as Woody. I hope you will enjoy this album of some of my favorite Woody Guthrie songs.
