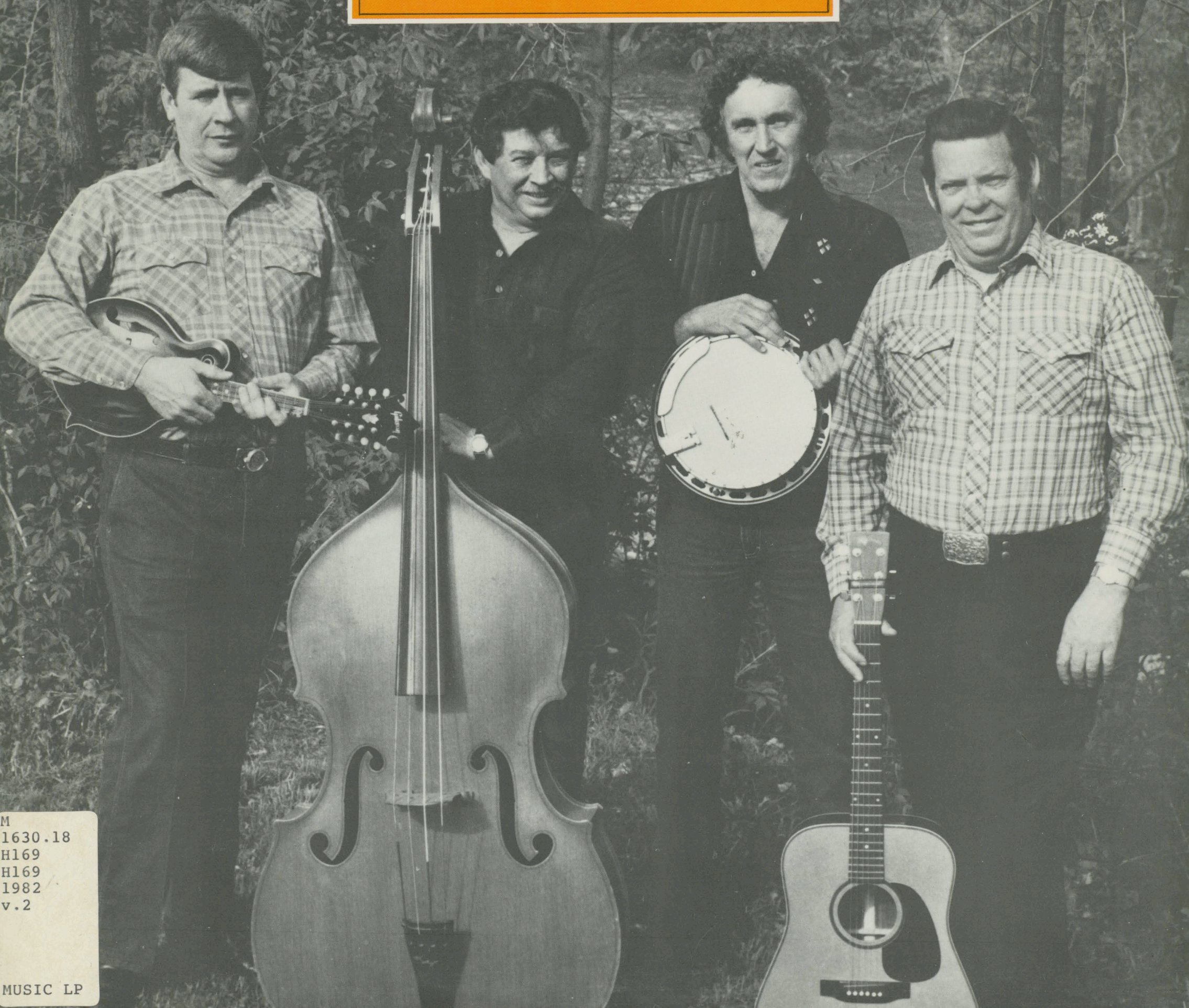

Jerry and Dave each contribute one modern C & W song "14 Karat Mind" and "Dream of Me", Dave does a great job on an old cowboy copas favorite, "Gone and Left Me Blues."

Harry pays tribute to old friend Ed Adcock with his, "El Dedo" and a new arrangement of an old standard you may recognize.

Dave does an old song he co-wrote some years back, "Old Kentucky Hills." Add one of Flatt & Scruggs' classics, "Someone Took My Place With You," an old Carter Family number, "Storms on the Ocean." Plus one of Johnny Cash's older tunes Jerry thought should have been a grass number, and you have our latest effort.

Dave Clark

Born in Kentucky moved to Ohio in the mid-fifties, played until recently with the West Virginia Travelers. Has worked with many groups in the Ohio area. Joined Half & Half Bluegrass Band as guitar player is considered one of the finer singers in bluegrass.

Jerry Butler

A West Virginia native worked several years with the West Virginia travelers before joining his brother Homer to form The Butler Bros. which worked several years in the West Virginia, Ohio, Pa. area. Spent recent years as a member of Red Allen's fine band The Kentuckians.

Harry Shaffer

Born in West Virginia, moved to Ohio in the early sixties. Joined with John Douglas to form The West Virginia Travelers, a band that has seen many fine musicians come and go including John's son Jerry. Worked as a member of Red Allen's Kentuckians until joining the Half & Half Bluegrass Band.

Charles Adkins

Another West Virginia boy has worked around the Ohio area with many fine groups. One of the better bass players around and a fine baritone singer Charlie is the latest member of the band.
