**ADA DE CASTRO**

Born in Lisbon, in the Castle quarter, she became a professional fado singer in 1959. She has worked in casinos, night-clubs, etc. and also in Italy, Germany, Switzerland, France, Spain and in the Portuguese Provinces of Azores and Madeira Islands. She has been in several short-length films and her face and voice are well known to TV and National Broadcast (Emissora Nacional) audiences in Portugal. She has been working for many years at the "Folclore Restaurante" with great success.



**LOURENÇO DE OLIVEIRA**

Born in Lisbon, he won a "fado" contest at the famous old "Cafe Luso" in 1957. He became a professional fado singer in 1960. During that year he went to Paris where he sang for a year, in a fado house. Then he returned to Lisbon and has been performing in many typical fado houses as well as on Portuguese TV and radio.



**SAUDADE DOS SANTOS**

In 1957 she won first prize in the "Queen of Fado Contest" which consisted of a trip to Portuguese Africa. The same year she became a professional fado singer. Since then she has recorded frequently and has made innumerable appearances on TV shows. She has also worked in the cinema, theater and radio, as well as in the best casinos and night-clubs in the country and in the four or five best typical restaurants in Lisbon.

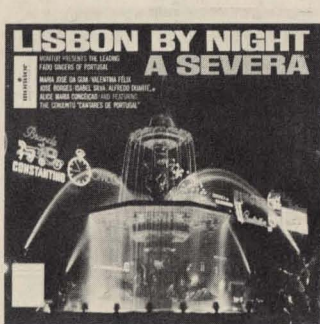
