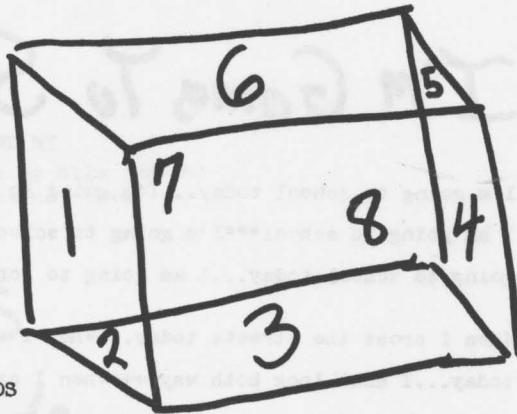

... A warm, sensitive artist who brings the joy of music to children, their teachers and their families through television, recordings and workshops in American and abroad. She is a thoughtful educator and a talented folksinger with a unique and personal teaching method for adults and children alike. Her workshops are designed to give non-musical adults, working with pre-school and early elementary children, simple and effective ways to teach sound, rhythm and body movement. Her entertainment delights both adults and children, bridging the generation gap with joyful sing-alongs.

Miss Jenkins was born in St. Louis and grew up in Chicago. She is a graduate of San Francisco State College where she studied Sociology, Psychology and Recreation. After graduation, she returned to Chicago and worked for four years as Teenage Program Director for the YWCA. Starting as a "free-lance rhythm specialist", she designed her own technique for developing music appreciation and group awareness in children through folk music and rhythms. She has recorded numerous folksong albums incorporating her techniques, is the author of two books on the subject, starred in her own TV show for children and has conducted countless workshops and sing-alongs across this country and abroad.

... Miss Richter has contributed many fine photographs to my record album booklets as well as album covers. She is a graduate of The Art Institute of Chicago with a Masters Degree in Fine Arts, specializing in Photography.
